The combined **International and North American Championship** regatta is just a few short weeks away and the following is a recap of logistical issues vis-à-vis getting boats to/from Bermuda from the U.S., as well as some additional information to help your regatta plans.

BUT FIRST A WORD FROM OUR SPONSORS...

The Bermudian organizing committee for the International and North American Championship has been doing a great job enlisting key sponsors for the regatta. Per this <u>press release</u> going out today, the Viper 640 Class Association is proud to announce that Aspen Insurance will be the title sponsor of the event and the long-term Viper supporter, EFG, will be the presenting sponsor. Officially, this regatta will be the "**Aspen Viper 640 International Championship presented by EFG**." SHIPPING BOATS FROM THE U.S. TO BERMUDA AND BACK AGAIN

The link at the end of this section is a very informative FAQ put together by the Regatta Committee in Bermuda. When reviewing this information relative to your specific plans, have the following thought in mind:

- 1. There are three outbound shipping points: Salem, NJ, Port Elizabeth, NJ (just south of NYC) and Fernandina Beach, FL (just north of Jacksonville)
- 2. Will you be sailing the October HPDO? If so, you will want to ship from Port Elizabeth or Salem.
- 3. Do you intend to sail any of the Sarasota Sailing Squadron Viper Winter Series (Dec, Jan, Feb) or Miami in March. If so, you may want to consider having your boat shipped back to Fernandina Beach and then delivered to SSS.
- 4. Be very mindful of the paperwork you will need to present when shipping and receiving your boats...all detailed in the FAQs.

There is a document in the Forms and Document section of the website that answers most (if not all) of your shipping and housing questions. Once an owner contacts a Shipping Agent they start down the path and things tend to proceed. <u>Logistics FAQs</u>.

HPDO ENTRY REGISTRATION DISCOUNT EXPIRES AUGUST 31

HPDO is Oct. 8-9 at American Yacht Club in Rye, NY. This is the final regatta in the WLIS Circuit and will be a great tune-up for Bermuda. Vipers always a great turnout at the HPDO-14 boats currently registered but there should be well over 25 on the starting line for the first gun. The more boats that sign up early, the better, since it encourages people to make the trip from Canada, the Chesapeake and other places.
