VIPER CLASS 2-SAIL BUTTONS NEEDED

Sailors are legendary non-readers of things like NoRs or SIs. It looks like many of you haven't been reading the Viper Class Rules either.



Effective 2018, every Viper sail will come from the sailmaker with a new Viper Sail Royalty patch (lower right in photo) already stitched onto the tack. This patch signifies you paid your \$50 sail royalty through the sailmaker when purchasing the sail.

In addition, each sail also needs the original Sail Registration patch (lower left) so the class can manage the one suit of sails per year rule. These patches once were how the Class collected the \$50 royalty, but now they are **FREE**...but you must have one.

If you've got a sail without a Sail Registration sticker, contact <u>Buttons Padin</u> ASAP giving him your boat number, date of the sail's first use, whether it's a main/jib/spinnaker, and the sailmaker. He'll get you your stickers in a jiffy.
